

Identity Theft Awareness Workshop October 4th in Wolfeboro and Ossipee

Wolfeboro, NH: Identity Theft is a growing problem in New Hampshire but are you really at risk? Identity theft is serious. While some victims can resolve their problems quickly, others spend hundreds of dollars and many days repairing damage to their good name and credit record. Some consumers victimized by identity theft may lose out on job opportunities, or be denied loans for business, housing, cars or education because of negative information on their credit reports. In rare cases, they may even be arrested for crimes they did not commit. Whether you have been a victim of identity theft or simply being proactive in protecting your identity you must attend this upcoming workshop.

On Saturday, October 4th Consumer Credit Counseling Services of NH-VT (CCCS NH-VT) will provide two FREE workshops called "IDENTITY THEFT AWARENESS". They will discuss some of the simple ways consumers unknowingly put themselves at risk and perhaps more importantly, what you can do to reduce your risk. They will also look at how people are being victimized and what to do if you should become a victim.
