The New Hampshire Small Business Development Center (NH SBDC) partnering with Wentworth Economic Development Corporation (WEDCO) will be providing business advising services to Wolfboro and the surrounding communities. Chris Duffy will be serving the area as an SBDC business advisor at the WEDCO office in Wolfboro.

The NH SBDC, an outreach program of UNH's Whittemore School of Business & Economics, provides confidential, long-term management counseling and education programs to more than 3,000 businesses each year. Client's ranging from early stage to well established businesses can access help in business planning; financial analysis; loan package development; start-up and acquisition and marketing and sales. The SBDC also offers a variety of e-tools including 21 in-line small business courses that can be accessed 24/7 through the web site [www.nhsbdc.org](http://www.nhsbdc.org). There is no cost to the client for the management consulting services. Service in Wolfboro is a result of a donation from Citizens Bank and Ocean Bank. The SBDC is a partnership with the US SBA, the State of NH, DRED, the University System of NH and the private sector.

Sample counseling topics include business planning, financial analysis, marketing, accounting, cash flow projections, and new business/acquisition feasibility and evaluation.
